



Case 18

- 12-year-old patient
- The patient had an explosion accident which caused a large physical damage, avulsion wound, large tissue laceration, and fractures in the first and third metacarpals.
- Clinical procedures: Wound's edges were debrided and limited, the lacerated tissues were removed, and the fractures metacarpals were fixed with plates. Bandages with silvadex have been applied for 10 days followed by debridement and removing the sphacelous tissues.
- Regen-D was applied for 9 days then skin grafting was made.
